### Activity Report (October)

Following the content of the regular meeting on September 28 (Secretary Hiroki Hayashi: "Promotion of Domestic Urushi"), we discussed at the club assembly on the theme of "Involvement in Urushi-related business". In order to think about what we can do in the long term, such as planting lacquer trees and lacking successors to craftsmen, we have decided to list the information collection destinations in the future, start collecting information from this year, and identify problems.

### •Revision of club bylaws (excerpt)

In order to broaden the base of members, we discussed with the members and revised the detailed rules. [Preliminary member]

- 1) Preliminary members are those who wish to join before regular membership registration.
- 2) Membership fees will be exempted during the preliminary membership period.
- [Supporting members]
- 1) Citizens and groups who agree with the purpose of the club's activities and wish to participate in the activities are designated as supporting members.
- 2) Supporting members must be recommended by at least one regular member of the club.
- 3) Supporting members are allowed to participate in our club's extraordinary meetings, service project committee meetings, and teams within the service project committee.

- White Team: Conduct activities for the purpose of medical and hygiene-related services.
- Green Team: Activities aimed at protecting the natural environment and providing services related to the Global Climate Pledge.
- Gold Team: Conduct activities for the purpose of primary industry development related service.
- Blue Team: Activities for the purpose of education-related service.

### •Green Team Activity Report

We shared the details of the signing of the "Global Climate Pledge" within the club. (Only the outline)

- 2) Team: Establish a Green Team that promotes the protection of the natural environment, and create accurate information dissemination and environmental protection programs.
