●Report: August 2023

1) Board of Directors

- A) Approval for promotion of Healthy Mowing Promotion (HEAMOP) project: Weed control during gardening and afforestation Weed control is unavoidable when growing plants, such as gardening and afforestation, which require a great deal of physical stress. Mowing for weed control places a heavy burden on the body, which can lead to degenerative spondylosis and lumbar disc herniation, which can lead to impairments in ADL. We recommend the use of wood chips to reduce the burden on the above. We provide garden shredders for woodchip production. The recipient will be the Oku Akiu Nojiri District Neighborhood Association. Raw materials are easily available in the area, and woodchip production, which can be completed with light labor, is expected to contribute to regional revitalization and branding in the aging area. The club's supplementary budget will be 100,000 yen.
- B) Approval regarding the operation of the homepage member-only site: Expand access privileges to supporting members to ensure quick sharing of information within the club. Stored information includes governor's monthly letter, regular meeting minutes, committee minutes, and other (club articles of incorporation, club bylaws, etc.)
- C) Increase the capacity of club management Google Drive (100GB purchase: 250 yen per month) and approve the club secretary's authority to delete unnecessary information
- D) Approval of revisions to club bylaws Clarification of authority order for executive officers
- E) Approval to hold the 2023-24 first term club general meeting November 19, 2020 at Hotel Monterey Sendai
- F) Approval regarding the election of president nominee: The Club Management and Operations Committee has jurisdiction over the Election Management Committee. The election will be announced on September 26th and held at the club general meeting on November 19th.
- G) Approved the expenditure of 20,000 yen for the 11 Rotary Clubs in Sendai's social golf tournament.
